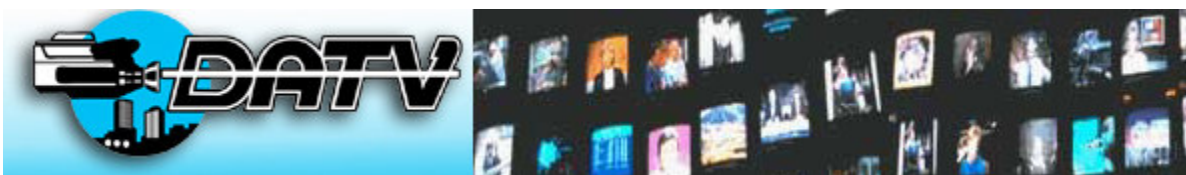

DATV Programs Named Award Winners

Dayton, Ohio - 10/19/06 - - Four DATV members have been named as winners of the Philo T. Farnsworth Video Awards presented by The Central States Region of the Alliance For Community Media.

The following locally produced programs were honored:

"Pigskin Glory" produced by Pat Jessee of Dayton won in the category of Sports Talk. "Pigskin Glory" is the story of University of Dayton's 1951 football team. It tells how this Division I team with a record of 5 wins and 2 losses went up against the University of Houston in the only bowl game Dayton ever played in. It was history in the making.



"Harper's Bazzaroworld" produced by Darryl Bohannon of Dayton won in the category of Cultural Diversity. "Harper's Bazzaroworld" is the first African American produced GLBT variety show in the Midwest. The show, a cross between the "Carol Burnett Show", "Late Night with David Letterman" and "The Muppet Show", airs Tuesdays at 10:30pm and Saturdays at 9:00pm

"The Enigma Files" produced by Brad Maddex of Riverside won in the category of Original Teleplay. "The Enigma Files" follows the case of a 1950's era detective.

"Phobia Art Show" produced by DATV Marketing Director Dan Suffoletto won in the Category of Cultural Event. The program featuring numerous local artists is an inside look at the Phobia Art Show held at Pearl Nightclub in Downtown Dayton. DATV also won in the category of Web Site for www.datv.org which is designed by Suffoletto.

The awards will be presented November 17th at the Alliance's Fall Conference and Trade Show in East Lansing Michigan.
